12 Saint Josaphat

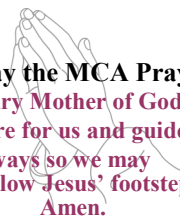
worked tirelessly to bring peace in the early church. Let us follow his example by praying and always promoting peace in our communities.

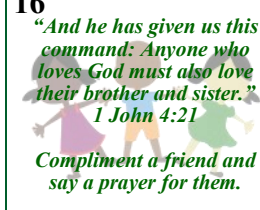

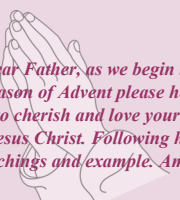
