**8** St. Therese of the Child Jesus is the patron saints of the missions. As we dedicate this month to the Missions. Take a moment to read about her life or the life of another saint.



**17 Saint Ignatius of Antioch** he was a martyr in the early church and Bishop of Antioch.


**18 Saint Luke**


