Bulletin board ideas and suggestions for mission awareness

Create a space in a classroom or school common area that serves as a reminder that we are all part of the universal church, which is constantly striving to evangelize and help others in need.

Families can be encouraged to create a sacred space in their homes, adding special devotions or faith traditions that are rooted in their cultural heritage. If they have a Marian devotion, add a picture or statue of Mary.

Teachers and catechist can add elements that remind children that as members of the body of Christ they are part of a diverse and vibrant church. Include things that show how the faith is expressed in different traditions we have.

Make it a colorful spot that reminds everyone of the beauty of God's creation and that we are his beloved children.

- Set up a mission corner at home or if you have an altar, add something relating to the missions.
- Have a day of the week where your whole family gathers to pray the world mission rosary.
- Make a giving jar that you can place in your mission corner for everyone to put donations for the missions. You can mail in your donations once a month.
- October is the month of the missions and the rosary. Pray a novena for the missions as a family using the world mission rosary. Visit our website to learn more about the WMR and get free resources.

## Teachers/Catechist

- Make a missionary quilt telling how everyone will answer their call to mission. Display the quilt for everyone to see.
- Share MCA material and online resources with children.
- Read the life of a Saint and talk about how they helped evangelize others or what their response was to God's mission for them.
- Be part of the MCA Youth Appreciation Mass, Wednesday October 19, 2022 at 10am at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels.
- Learn a song or hymn that talks about how we are continuing the evangelization efforts of the church.
- Pray the world mission rosary with everyone participating outdoors.
- Celebrate mission awareness week, Monday October 17, 2022 through Sunday October 23, 2022.
- Most children in mission countries can't buy toys. Have the children make toys together with what they have at home. Have a contest to see who makes the best one. Put the toys they make on display.
