He is the patron saint of Monterey, California. Can you find it on a map?



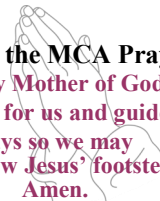

 She is the Patron saint of immigrants and hospital administrators.



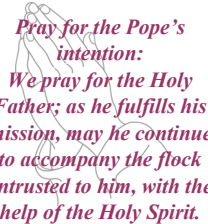
She came from Italy to serve the immigrant community in the United States in 1889.

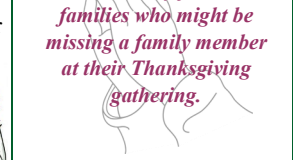


**24 Saint Andrew Dũng-Lạc and Companions**

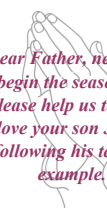
